IMPORTANT NOTICE TO OCCUPANT UNDER THE CANADIAN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT

In accordance with Environment and Climate Change Canada – Environmental Emergency Regulations under the Canadian Environmental Protection Act, facilities where a regulated substance is stored shall inform members of the public within the hazard distance of the facility that the location could potentially be involved in an environmental emergency. The regulated substance is propane stored at the Avenir Energy Ltd. Facility.

The likelihood of any incident at the Avenir Energy Ltd. facility affecting your location is extremely low. The Environmental Emergency Regulations requires all facilities where the amount of the hazardous substance exceeds defined thresholds, to notify all those members of the public that could potentially be affected by an environmental emergency of the potential consequences and the measures that will be taken in the event of an emergency.

The consequences of an environmental emergency that could potentially impact your location include:

- A fire at the facility or an adjacent location resulting in the failure of a propane vessel resulting in a fireball and/or an explosion
- A leak of propane at the facility resulting in the risk of a fire or a vapour cloud explosion

The Avenir Energy Ltd. facility is licensed and governed by the local Regulatory Authority. The facility operates to ensure risks to surrounding land uses are within acceptable public safety criteria. Avenir Energy Ltd. has installed redundant safety features to minimize the risk of an incident occurring.

During an emergency occurrence at the facility, personnel will shut down the terminal and evacuate the facility. In the event of a large scale municipal emergency, a team of qualified professionals from the local Fire Department will work together to co-ordinate the emergency response. In the event of an environmental emergency, you will be given direction and guidance regarding evacuation or other necessary actions from the local emergency services and/or their designate.
